This privacy policy is intended to help you understand what data Astralis Recruitment Group Ltd. (Astralis) collects, why that data is collected, how we use your information and how we protect any information that you give to Astralis when you use this website.

Astralis is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected and, should you provide certain information by which you can be identified when using this website, it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

This policy is effective from 21st May 2018.

What we collect:

We may collect the following information:

- name and job title;
- contact information including email address;
- career history;
- demographic information such as postcode, preferences and interests;
- other information relevant to customer surveys and/or offers.

How we use the information we gather:

We use the information we collect to understand your recruitment or career needs and to provide you with a better service for the following reasons:

- Internal record keeping;
- We may use the information to improve our products and services;
- We may periodically send information such as surveys, press /online articles about newsletters which we believe may be of interest using the email address which you have provided.

Security:

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.



How we use cookies:

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

We use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about web page traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to customer needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system.

Overall, cookies help us provide you with a better website, by enabling us to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.

Links to other websites:

Our website may contain links to other websites of interest. However, once you have used these links to leave our site, you should note that we do not have any control over that other website. Therefore, we cannot be responsible for the protection and privacy of any information which you provide whilst visiting such sites and such sites are not governed by this privacy statement. Controlling your personal information:

You may choose to restrict the collection or use of your personal information but please be assured that we will not sell, distribute or lease your personal information to third parties at any time unless we have your permission or are required by law to do so.

Information that we share:

We may process your data for the purposes of maintaining internal records or for the purposes of sharing employment opportunities with you.
